What you need to know about the COVID-19 outbreak Symptoms

- * Fever
- * Cough
- * Shortness of Breath

<u>Seek medical attention</u> <u>if you :</u>

- <u>* Develop symptoms or</u>
- * Have been in close contact with a person known to have COVID-19.

What can you do?

- * Wash hands whenever possible for at least 20 seconds.
- * If soap is not available use hand sanitizer.
- * Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- * If you think you are infected, keep away from others.
- * Clean your living space as often as you can.
- * Avoid sharing personal items such as cigarettes, food, utensils etc.
- * Limit your time away from camp or apartment.
